With regard to any item listed in this Agenda below, the Board may, by motion, recess into executive session for discussion or consultation for legal advice with the attorney or attorneys of the public body in accordance with ARS §38-431.03(A)(3).

The Board may change the order of the agenda at the time of convening the meeting or at any time during the meeting. The Chairman may call on members of the public to speak on any item posted on the agenda. One or more members of the Board may attend either in person or by telephone, video or Internet conferencing.

Call to the Public – In accordance with ARS §38-431.01(H), a public body may make an open call to the public during a public meeting, subject to reasonable time, place and manner restrictions, to allow individuals to address the public on any issue within the jurisdiction of the public body. At the conclusion of an open call to the public, individual members of the public body may respond to criticism made by those who have addressed the public body, may ask staff to review a matter or may ask that a matter be put on a future agenda. However, members of the public body shall not discuss or take legal action on matters raised during an open call to the public unless the matters are properly noticed for discussion and legal action.
